

Quilted Fabric Pictures – Beginner Focus

The beginner class is for those sewers who have never made a landscape or fabric picture before. Pet portraits or house pictures are at the intermediate level focus.

Bring to first class:

- 1" binder with rings
- Your sewing machine (our classroom is on the second floor so you might want to put the machine in some sort of luggage on wheels. There is an elevator at the high school)
- Light blue or sky material - 3 pieces each 3x6 inches
- 3 muslin scraps (each minimum of 9x6 inches)
- Fabric scissors
- Straight pins
- Pencil or pen
- Plastic sleeves (to put handouts in)
- Thread/bobbins in shades of green/purple/brown

Optional:

- Cutting mat
- Rotary cutter

Before first class:

- Look at teacher's website www.thequiltedjardin.com for ideas of what fabric pictures can be.
- Begin gathering different photographs that you or friends/family have taken of simple landscapes. Put them in your notebook.
- If you know what you want to create as part of this class, bring a picture or drawing and the sky material you are thinking of using. If you don't know what project you want to do, that's perfectly fine. We'll talk about that during the first class.
