

Quilted Fabric Pictures –Intermediate focus

Intermediate class focus is on learning shading and thread painting techniques to accentuate the fabric picture and achieve more realistic appearance.

Bring to first class:

- 1" binder with rings
- Tracing paper for creating pattern
- Pencil or pen
- Paper scissors
- Ziploc type bag
- Colored pencils
- Plastic sleeves (to put handouts in)
- The fabrics you are thinking of using for your design including the background
- Your design: 1) Choose a photo you'd like to recreate (do not use copyrighted material) 2) Have it enlarged in black and white to the desired final size of your fabric picture. 3) Have two copies made. 4) Bring both the original picture and enlargements to class.

- Fusible web
- Stabilizer
- Sewing Machine
- Thread/ bobbins
- Straight pins
- Fabric scissors
